Fee Issue Leads Dean To End Lecture Tour

SANTA ANA, Calif., March 16 (AP)—John Dean 3d, President Nixon's former counsel, said last night that he was ending his college lecture tour because his fees were becoming the issue and not what he had to say about Watergate.

Mr. Dean's lecture tour, which began Feb. 2 at the University of Virginia, has been marked by protests and attempts to block his fees of \$2,000 or more. Santa Ana College officials said that Mr. Dean had been paid \$3,500 plus \$200 in expenses.

A student asked Mr. Dean about his fees and he replied that the press had been exaggerating the tour's lucrativeness by quoting the expense to each college and not pointing out that his agent gets half.
