Nancy Kissinger
Disliked Nixon

Nancy Kissinger disliked and distrusted former President Nixon and told her husband so, but kept her views from the public out of sympathy for his family, the Ladies Home Journal says.

In an article by CBS correspondent Marvin Kalb, read and approved by the wife of the secretary of state, Mrs. Kissinger is described as telling her husband, Henry, "quite often" how she felt about Mr. Nixon.

"She thought that he was somewhat unstable, and that this quality, more than any other, led to his downfall," Kalb wrote in the magazine's April issue.

"Kissinger didn't argue with her, but his service to Mr. Nixon was never influenced by her feelings. Kissinger rationalized the whole thing by saying that he was serving the Presidency, not the President; the nation, not the Republican party."
