Of Fund-Raiser TAMPA, Fla., March 31 (UPI)—A former Florida Re-publican official testified to-day he learned in 1971 that a fund-raiser for former Sen. Edward Gurney, on trial for bribery and conspiracy, was using "strong-arm" tactics to extract political contributions from builders. But former State GOP Finance Committee Chairman George Anderson, being cross-examined by defense attor-neys, said he did not tell the senator about the activities of fund-raiser Larry Williams. Anderson continued to be cross-examined by defense lawyers today as the bribery-conspiracy trial of Gurney and fourney's attorney, C. Harris bittmar, Anderson recalled a tephone conversation with former Democratic guberna-torial candidate Brailey Od-ham in which Odham told him Williams had tried to "strong-arm" him into buykug a \$500 ticket to a Nixon dinnet.
