Watergate statute expires

WASHINGTON — The statute of limitations ran out yesterday on prosecution of illegal campaign contributions to Richard M. Nixon before April 7, 1972.

Before the new federal election campaign act became effective on that date, fund-raisers for President Nixon gathered about \$20 million, much of it in illegal corporate contributions.

Watergate prosecutors eventually got guilty pleas from 17 corporations and 15 corporate officials, mostly in connection with these contributions.

The statute of limitations ran out on the prosecution of any additional violations that may have ocal, curred before April 7, 1972.

Jules Witcover says the statute of limitations is five years.
