Morgan Released From U.S. Prison

LOMPOC, Calif. (AP)—Edward L. Morgan has been released after four months in prison for conspiring to illegally arrange a \$576,000 tax deduction for President Nixon.

Morgan was sentenced to the federal minimum security prison camp here after pleading guilty to illegally backdating a deed for Nixon's pre-presidential papers that were donated to the government.

A prison spokesman said Morgan, who entered Lompoc Jan. 6, worked in the prison power station.
