**After Term for Tax Plot**

LOMPOC, Calif., April 23 (AP)—Edward L. Morgan was released Wednesday after serving four months in prison for conspiring to arrange an illegal \$576,000 tax deduction for former President Richard M. Nixon.

Mr. Morgan, deputy counsel in the Nixon Administration, was sentenced to the Federal minimum security prison camp here after pleading guilty to illegally back-dating a deed for Mr. Nixon's donation of papers to the Government.
