OF \$500,000 PAYOFF

TAMPA, Fla., May 6 (AP)

Larry Williams testified today that as a fund-raiser for Senator Edward J. Gurney he collected \$500,000 from Florida builders for influence on Federal housing projects.

Another payoff, Williams said in the bribery conspiracy trial of Mr. Gurney and four others, took the form of a free \$56,000 condominium at Vero beach, which the former Republican Senator agreed to accept but eventually bought.

In August, 1971, Mr. Williams told Senator Gurney of the offer from the late John Dye, am Orlando architect-builder, after explaining that it was a payoff for housing favors, Mr. Williams said.
