Leonard Garment was named by President Ford yesterday to be the United States representative on the Human Rights Commission of the United Nations Economic and Social Council. Mr. Garment, who was a member of the law firm here that Richard M. Nixon joined in 1963, was Mr. Nixon's special consultant on minority affairs and later White House counsel before resigning last year. A graduate of Brooklyn College and the Brooklyn Law School, Mr. Garment, 51 years old, has resumed practice here with another firm; he lives in Brooklyn Heights with his wife and two children.

In Norfolk, Va., Rear Adm. Jeremiah Denton, the highest ranking American prisoner of war released by North Vietnam, announced his return home from captivity today in a ceremony at the Norfolk Naval Air Station.
