Edward Morgan, the former volving the former President's Treasury Department official back-dating of more than 500,-

who pleaded guilty to falsifying Richard M. Nixon's tax returns, was barred yesterday from practicing law before the Supreme Court.

The court ordered Morgan's name stricken from its list.

Morgan served four months of a two-year jail sentence and was released in April after pleading guilty in November, 1974, to one count of conspiracy to obstruct the Internal Revenue Service in a case indal.
