Anthropologists disclaim any knowledge of a Marine footlocker reported once seen somewhere in northern San Diego county with Peking Man bones spirited out of China. However, the San Diego Museum of Man is ready to authenticate the bones if they're found and if they're real. The museum has a large rare collection of plaster casts made from the real fossils before they disappeared in 1941. Dr. Spencer Rogers, the museum's scientific director, tells of the originals being lost.

Dr. Rogers [voice]: The train on which the fossils were being carried was held up by bandits. At that point everything goes rather blank, because the shipments never reached a port of debarkation and there was no further authentic information about them.

Announcer: Dr. Rogers says, "If they brought that footlocker to us and it has skulls in it, we can make a very good determination quite readily."
