Vibrations

For Nixon

San Clemente

Secret Service agents have prevented former President Nixon from receiving some positive vibrations offered by a man who calls himself Zoom.

Zoom, wielding an iron skillet he says radiates positive vibrations, paid a call at La Casa Pacifica Tuesday, but was turned away by the Secret Service.

Later Zoom dropped by the local police station seeking aid for a sore foot. "He said he wanted to see Mr. Nixon and if he could possibly radiate his vibrations, things would get better for him," recalled officer Dwayne Herberich.

Police said the man is Ronald D. Hamilton, 33, of Santa Monica. Firemen and policemen performed first aid on a gash on his foot and took him for further treatment to San Clemente General Hospital.
