'Considers'

Move to N.Y.

Washington

Richard Nixon is "definitely considering" moving from California to Bronxville, N.Y., according to U.S. News & World Report.

The magazine yesterday quoted associates of the former president as saying he may "engage in projects with his close friend, multimillionaire Robert Abplanalp, who has a home near Bronxville."

Abplanalp and Charles G. (Bebe) Rebozo are said to have urged Mr. Nixon to sell his San Clemente estate as a way of getting out of a financial bind, the magazine said.
