Nixon Said Pondering Move

Former President Nixon may sell his San Clemente, Calif., estate and move to Bronxville, N.Y., a New York City suburb, according to U.S. News & World Report.

Quoting the former President's associates, the magazine said Nixon is "definitely considering" the move so that he "may engage in projects with his close friend, multi-millionaire Robert Abplanalp, who has a home near Bronxville."

The magazine said that Abplanalp and C. G. (Bebe) Rebozo, another close Nixon

friend, have urged Nixon to sell his San Clemente property to assist in meeting his substantial financial obligations.

However, Leo Murray, assistant director of public relations for Precision Valve Corp., which Abplanalp owns, quoted Abplanalp as saying he was "unaware of any specific plans relating to the disposal of San Clemente or of Mr. Nixon moving East."

Murray said Abplanalp added that he knows of no plans for joint projects with the former President.
