Nixon Depositions Are Held Unlikely

Sen. John Tower (R-Tex.) said yesterday that it does not appear at the moment that [the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence Operations] will seek depositions from former President Nixon on possible assassination plots against Cuban Premier Fidel Castro in the 1950s when Nixon was Vice President.

But another committee spokesman said Nixon might be called later as a witness on other [CIA] issues slated for investigation.
