

Agnew Seeks Coors License

GOLDEN, Colo., Aug. 4 (UPI)—The Adolph Coors Co. said today that former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew has applied for a license to distribute Coors beer in Texas.

The company said Agnew was scheduled to meet with a sales representative of the brewery about the application. Coors said no decision would be made "for quite some time."

A company spokesman said Agnew applied with a resident of Texas to distribute the beer in Texas. The name of the co-applicant and the site of the proposed distributorship were not released.

"Just recently, we announced we were going to expand our distribution area to include the rest of the state of Texas," the spokesman said. "Since that time, we've talked to literally hundreds of applicants for distributorships."

"Mr. Agnew's application will be processed exactly the same as all the rest. These are just preliminary discussions."
