John V. Brennan, who resigned from the Marine Corps July 31 as a lieutenant colonel, has begun work in San Clemente, Calif., as the head of Richard M. Nixon's personal staff. Mr. Brennan, a 38-year-old former military aide to the former President, has worked part-time on his staff while stationed at nearby Camp Pendleton, including 66 days of accrued leave. Mr. Brennan's undisclosed salary reportedly will be paid from Mr. Nixon's \$96,000 annual Federal allotment for office salaries, Rose Mary Woods, who was on the White House payroll for \$36,000 as the President's secretary and remained as head of Mr. Nixon's Washington staff, is said to be retiring on a \$27,500-a-year Federal pension.
