yesterday it has withdrawn from negotiations for the exclusive television rights to former President Richard M. Nixon's memoirs.

Richard C. Wald, NBC News president, said in a statement that Nixon agent Irving P. Lazar was "having discussions with others who are prepared to pay more for the rights evidently and might be more compatible with the former President's wishes" in how the memoirs,

1976 or 1977, might be presented.

Wald suggested that inclusion of background film on the Watergate story in the proposed NBC version of proposed NBC version of the memoirs, as well as La-zar's reported \$750,000 ask-ing price for three or four one-hour programs, were the stumbling blocks in the ne-gotiations, said to be termi-nated mutually. Lazar is re-portedly also dickering with producer David Frost this producer David Frost this week in California.
