9:15 THE WHITE HOUSE TRANSCRIPTS (Parts 1, 2, 3) A 90-minute special built upon selected portions of transcripts released by former President Nixon (including the significantly different versions presented by the House Committee of the Judiciary of the June 23, 1972, conversation—revelation of which led directly to Nixon's resignation). The production has been reenacted by professional actors who resemble the actual participants physically and vocally, portraying Nixon, Haldeman, Ehrlichman, Dean, Ziegler, Mitchell and others. When first broadcast nearly a year ago, reviewers found it "eerie," "high drama," "maybe the TV year's most fascinating." Yet the producers clearly took pains to assure that events are portrayed with objectivity, without editorialization. Nixon is portrayed by Harry Spillman, H.R. Haldeman by Jon Terry, John D. Ehrlichman by Glenn Kezer and John Dean, III by Russell Horton.
