

Chapin Begins Sentence

LOMPOC, Calif. Aug. 11. (AP) —Dwight L. Chapin, a former White House official began serving Monday* a 10-to-30-month prison term for lying to a Watergate grand jury. Mr. Chapin, the White House appointments secretary under President Nixon, was convicted of lying about the extent of his knowledge regarding the political "dirty tricks" carried out by Donald Segretti, whom Mr. Chapin had hired.
