

**Nixon's Old Law Office
To Have Memorabilia**

LA HABRA, Calif., Aug. 12 (UPI)—Two businessmen have paid \$25,000 for the building that housed Richard M. Nixon's law office and plan to restore the structure and turn it into a library housing memorabilia of the former President's private and political life.

Donald L. Bendetti, 47 years old, of Long Beach, Calif., and John Barr, 45, of Downey, Calif., said yesterday that final arrangements for them to take over trusteeship of Nixon Law Office Perservation, Inc., were completed Friday. *NS*

They estimated they would spend \$25,000 more to restore the 25-foot-by-80-foot one-story building presently occupied by the La Habra Chamber of Commerce, which will move by Sept. 15.
