No U.S. Jobs for Watergate Men

A White House spokesman said yesterday that no former Nixon administration appointees who pleaded guilty to minor Watergate-related crimes are being considered for appointment by President Ford.

Columnist Jack Anderson said Mr. Ford was considering granting presidential appointments to, among others, former Attorney General Richard Kleindienst, former White House aide Harry Dent and former Representative Wenl Wyatt (R-ore.).

All three pleaded guilty to law violations in Watergate-related cases.
