

Nixon Goes to a Birthday Party

Former President Nixon showed up at one of his favorite restaurants to have dinner and celebrate a birthday Saturday. (6 12 75)

Mr. Nixon arrived at the El Adobe restaurant accompanied by his wife, Pat; his daughter and son-in-law, Julie and David Eisenhower, and Colonel Jack Brennan, the former President's Personal aide.

While Mr. Nixon was President, he frequently ate at the restaurant, located about 10 miles from his San Clemente home.

The chef of the restaurant was given short notice to prepare a birthday cake for Brennan at the request of Mr. Nixon. It was a six-layered angel food cake topped with three candles.

Brennan was heard to say jokingly that he was 39.

The party of five ate undisturbed for about two hours on the balcony of the main dining room, but as the party began to leave, about 200 persons who had crowded around the entrance asked Mr. Nixon for his autograph and wished him well.
