

Nixon Celebrates Birthday

Of His Aide at Restaurant

SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO, Calif., Aug. 17 (UPI)—Former President Richard M. Nixon showed up at one of his favorite restaurants to have dinner and celebrate a birthday yesterday.

Mr. Nixon arrived at the El Adobe Restaurant accompanied by his wife, Pat; his daughter and son-in-law, Julie and David Eisenhower, and Col. Jack Brennan, his aide.

Secret Service agents called the restaurant about an hour before the Nixon party arrived. The chef of the restaurant was given short notice to prepare a birthday cake for Colonel Brennan at Mr. Nixon's request. As the party left, 200 persons crowded around the entrance asked Mr. Nixon for his autograph and wished him well.
