Since Agnew filed, hundreds of letters have been received by Coors opposed to the application.

Agnew applied after the company announced earlier this year it was expanding marketing operations in Texas. the application.

"Agnew said he felt in light of recent publicity that it would only be fair to the people he was associated with the people
