A conservative Republican multi-millionaire, **Jack M. Eckerd**, who has run unsuccessfully in Florida for Governor and Senator, is said to be **President Ford's** choice to head the General Services Administration. White House sources said Mr. Eckerd was undergoing a routine security-check for appointment to the 40,000-employee Federal housekeeping agency, succeeding **Arthur F. Sampson**, a Nixon Administration hold-over. The 62-year-old resident of Clearwater, Fla., owns a chain of over 200 drugstores and other businesses in the South and listed his net wealth at \$80-million last year.
