## Nixon's Debt in Legal Fees Is Put at About \$250,000

Rabbi Korff gave a \$23,000 check to one of Mr. Nixon's lawyers yesterday, reducing the amount owned thus far to \$238,448, including \$64,841 the Washington law firm of Miller, Larocca and Lewin billed the former President for the months of July and August.
