Former President Nixon was ordered yesterday to answer questions under oath as a defendant in a civil suit.

U.S. District Judge John Lew's is Smith Jr., said that only Preside dent Ford can invoke presidential confidentiality on behalf of his predecessor and that Mr. Ford a has not done so.

Mr. Nixon is being sued by Morton Halperin, a former staff member of the National Security Council, for wiretaps on Halperin's telephone for 21 months in 1969-70. The suit also names Secretary of State Henry Kissinger, and others as defendants.

Halperin seeks damages that could be in excess of \$300,000.
