## Details of Secret CIA Mail Surveillance Told Nixon Will Be Asked to Testify

Washington

[The members of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence] agreed unanimously to ask Mr. Nixon to testify in its wide-ranging probe of improper activities by U.S. agencies.

Chairman Frank Church (Dem-Idaho) said committee members felt Mr. Nixon himself was the "best witness" in a number of areas, including questions surrounding the short-lived Muston plan to give intelligence agencies sanction to break the law at times.

Mr. Nixon is not being called under subpoena, and Church would not say when or in what manner Mr. Nixon might appear.
