Agnew Now an Owner Of Ocean City Condo

OCEAN CITY, Md. (AP)—Spiro T. Agnew, who vacationed regularly at an oceanfront cottage here when he was Vice President, has purchased a \$62,000 condominium in a high-rise building on the ocean.

According to the roster of occupants for English Towers, another condominium owner in the oceanfront building is J. Walter Jones, an Annapolis banker and close Agnew friend.

A deed filed recently in Worcester County recorded the purchase of the 11th-floor ocean-view apartment by Agnew from Victor H. Laws, a Salisbury lawyer and Wicomico County councilman.

Laws said Monday he purchased the apartment in 1972 as a speculative venture.

"It didn't work out and I decided to take a loss and get out," said Laws. He said Agnew did not attend the settlement on the condominium.
