Over dinner at the Four Seasons last Friday, **John D. Ehrlichman** and representatives of his publishers, Simon & Schuster, decided that "The Company" would be the title of his novel based on the Watergate episode. The former White House aide finished the final draft here Sunday. Mr. Ehrlichman was here for a few days from Santa Fe, N.M., wearing the beard he has grown while living there. **Richard Snyder**, S. & S. president, said yesterday that the 300-page novel would be published next summer. In London, a spokesman for Wm. Collins Sons & Co. Ltd., which has bought the British rights, said, "All I know about the novel is that everybody in it is fictitious, including the President." Said Mr. Snyder: "I would call that a wonderful description."
