

Kissinger's Hole in Great Wall Story

Secretary of State Henry Kissinger was asked Saturday if he would say anything that historic when Kissinger this week again stands at the wall.

The secretary replied: "Do you think he thought that up all by himself?"

Was the secretary implying it was not Mr. Nixon who formulated the "Great Wall" remark?

Kissinger, however, declined to elaborate and tramped off into the snow.
