

Ruling Against Miss Woods

WASHINGTON, Dec. 5 (AP)—A Federal judge today temporarily blocked Rose Mary Woods from removing 50 cardboard cartons from among the files accumulated by Mr. Nixon, when he was President.

Miss Woods, Mr. Nixon's secretary and assistant in the White House, had sought permission to recover what she said were personal and private items from among millions of documents tied up in a complicated legal fight.

United States District Judge Aubrey E. Robinson had agreed to allow Miss Woods to take possession of the items, which include materials relating to the 18½-minute tape gap.
