Rose Mary Woods, who served as personal secretary to President Nixon, has retired from the government payroll, the General Services Administration said yesterday.

Woods, 58, who earned \$36,000 a year, remained on the GSA payroll after Mr. Nixon resigned Aug. 9, 1974, until her own retirement on November 22, 1975. She was paid as part of a transition staff for the former president.

She reportedly will receive an annual pension of \$15,000.
