### Justice Officials Ordered To Release Agnew Papers

WASHINGTON, Dec. 16 (AP) —Justice Department officials may face contempt citations unless they release by Dec. 22 certain documents relating to the Government's investigation in 1973 of former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew.

Federal District Judge June L. Green threatened the sanctions if Jervis Finney, the Unit-

ed States attorney in Maryland, "doesn't come up with something in one week."

On Oct. 8, Judge Green ordered the department to turn over some Agnew documents to two law students, Roy Baldwin and Bruce Feder, who sought the papers under the Freedom of Information Act.

To date, Mr. Finney has released a 40-page recital of evidence against Mr. Agnew.
