Press Aide Has Resigned

John W. Hushen has resigned as a deputy White House press secretary, it was announced yesterday.

Hushen, 40, joined the White House at the start of the Ford administration in August, 1974. He previously had served as director of public information at the Justice Department under five attorneys general.

Hushen was the second deputy press secretary to depart the White House in recent weeks. Former deputy William Greener has transferred to the Pentagon as an assistant secretary of defense for public affairs.
