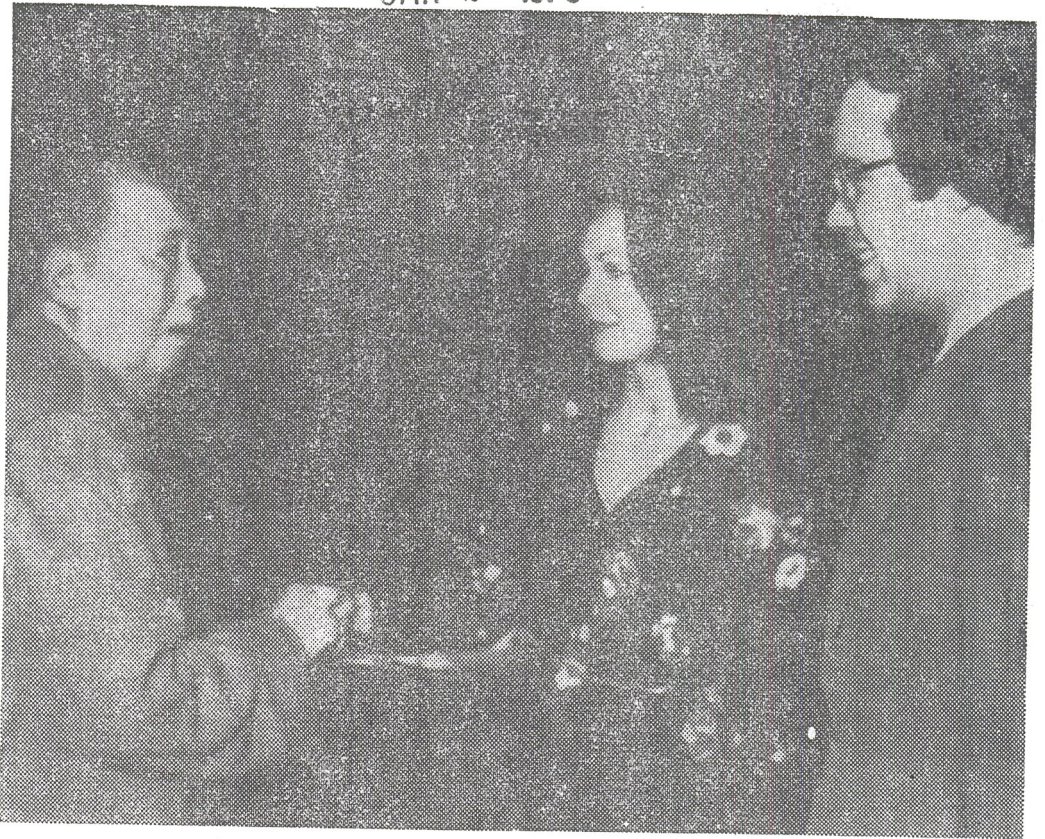

Two Congresspeople will be married Saturday—to each other.

Rep. Martha Keys of Kansas and Rep. Andrew Jacobs of Indiana will wed in a private ceremony in Topeka, Kan., with Mrs. Keys' four children by a previous marriage as witnesses. Both are Democrats and both will seek reelection this year.

Actor Richard Attenborough, whose specialty in war movies was the scared kid who dies a hero, is now a Sir.

Today a director as well as an actor, 52-year-old Attenborough was knighted in Queen Elizabeth's New Year's honors list.

Also "knighted" was opera singer Janet Baker, who becomes Dame Janet. ban, advertising director Richard Tullar has announced. He cited "changing attitudes" among readers, some of whom felt the policy was a form of censorship.

Two Soviet children, apparently switched by accident in a Moldavian nursing home 13 years ago, have now been placed in an orphanage while courts try to untangle the situation.

On June 12, 1963, blonde Ksenia Tanasov and swarthy Maria Zaldo gave birth to boys; Mrs. Tanasov was given a dark-skinned baby whom she named Valery, and Mrs. Zaldo was given a fair-skinned baby whom she named Sergei.

Three years ago the mixup was revealed when both boys were entered in the same school. The senior Tanasov, who is far more economically secure than his counterpart, tried to take Sergei through lawsuits and, failing that, by kidnapping him.

The Moldavian Supreme Court finally put the boys in an orphanage until they are old enough to choose which parents they want. Which means that both sets of parents visit blonde Sergei, whom they claim as theirs, and no one visits dark-haired Valery. The case was reported in the Moscow Literary Gazette.
