David Elsenhower, son-in-law of former President Nixon, said yesterday that during his recent trip to China he and his wife, Julie, were told by Deputy Premier Teng Hsiao-ping that the Chinese "do not attach any significance to Water-gate." gate."

Teng made the comments during dinner with the couple in Peking, Eisenhower said.

At the time, Teng appeared to be in line to succeed the late Chou En-Lai as China's premier, but he was bypassed last Saturday,) when Hua Kuo-feng was named acting premier.

On February 6, it was announced that Mr. Nixon and his wife, Pat, will go to China on February 21.
