Ford 'Told All on Nixon Pardon'

President Ford, in prior testimony, gave a complete and accurate story of the pardon he granted former President Nixon, White House press secretary Ron Nessen said yesterday.

Nessen commented after reporters asked him about a story in the Washington Post saying that four of the seven members of a House judiciary subcommittee want to investigate reports that Mr. Ford has not told the full story.

Mr. Ford appeared before the subcommittee on Oct. 17, 1974, to testify about the pardon.

Nessen said Mr. Ford's state-

ment at that time "was a complete and accurate story at a time when memories were much fresher."

In his testimony, Mr. Ford said, "At no time after I became President on Aug. 9, 1974, was the subject of a pardon for Richard M. Nixon raised by the former President or by anyone representing him."
