3:15 p.m. -- Bob [?] Bremner of LA Times called, saying Chinese plane already was at Vancouver. Still undecided whether it would pick Nixon up at El Toro Marine base or at LA International Airport, or whether Nixon would fly to Vancouver to get on the Chinese plane.

5:15 p.m. -- Steve Talbot of Internews called, saying Reuter had just brought in a story saying Chinese Boeing 707, which had been at Vancouver two days, would pick Nixon up at LA International, ~~xxxxxx~~ ARRIVING AT 6 A.M. The plane is one of 10 China bought from Boeing in 1972 [?].
