

A New Job for Ruckelshaus

William D. Ruckelshaus Jr., the first head of the Environmental Protection Agency, will join the Weyerhaeuser Co. starting in August.

George Weyerhaeuser, company president, said Ruckelshaus, a casualty in former President Richard Nixon's "Saturday night massacre," will be the firm's senior vice president for law and corporate affairs.

The 43-year-old Washington, D.C., lawyer will manage Weyerhaeuser's law department, its lobbyists, public relations and advertising departments.
