Announcer: A China scholar, Harvard Professor John Fairbank, is quoted by a Tokyo newspaper as saying Secretary of S+ate Kissinger may go to China this fall to work on U.S. diplomatic recognition of the Peking government. Fairbank is further quoted as saying Kissinger's visit in September would come off if President Ford wins the Republican nomination. Fairbank has been a State Department consultant from time to time.
