At the request of Richard M. Nixon, the former President, a three-judge Federal panel in Washington yesterday ordered that a hand-made flag fashioned from tatters by a prisoner of war who spent six years in captivity in Vietnam be returned to the Philadelphia-born veteran so that he might carry it in a July 4 parade. The flag, presented to Mr. Nixon while he was President, was in the collection of documents and memorabilia impounded by the Government for inspection to discern whether there was any Watergate-related material in it. Lieut. Col. John Dramesi, who made the flag, will have to return it to the archives by Sept. 15.
