.... [Mr. Nixon] arrived shortly after the doctors finished their public statements. A woman waiting in the lobby to visit her mother said Mr. Nixon looked rested but worried and that he smiled when she approached him to tell him, "I love you. I always have."

Dr. Lundgren says Mrs. Nixon's high blood pressure is now down somewhat and she has no history of hypertension.

Lundgren [voice]: Mrs. Nixon does not spend much time with physicians, and her last physical examination was about approximately two years ago, 18 months to two years ago. She had normal blood pressure at that time, and I talked to Dr. Lukash just a few minutes ago and in the time he was at the White House as an assistant to the White House physician he mentioned to me that she had no [out of the way?] blood pressure.
