.... Doctors are encouraged that Mrs. Nixon's spirits appear to be up, and the fact that the stroke that has left her semi-paralyzed has been stabilized. Meanwhile, hospital spokesperson Karen Krantz [? - garbled] says that messages and flowers continue to pour in for the former First Lady.

Krantz [voice]: When the messages [come in?] I forward them to the floor, for the family. And now, let's see --

Interviewer: What about flowers, and those things?

Krantz: The flowers are, I believe, being brought up so that the family can see them and then they are being distributed to other patients in the hospital.

Interviewer: Ms. Krantz has also commented on a report that Mrs. Nixon's two attending physicians disagree on the cause of the stroke. She says as far as she knows there is no disagreement between the Nixon family physician, Dr. John Lundgren, and the consulting neurologist, Dr. Jack Mosier.
