Set to Leave Hospital Today

Former First Lady Pat Nixon will be discharged from the hospital this morning, two weeks after suffering a partially paralyzing stroke, a family spokesman said yesterday.

Colonel Jack Brennan said doctors have determined Mrs. Nixon has recovered sufficiently to return to San Clemente and continue therapy at home.

Mrs. Nixon was taken to Long Beach Memorial Hospital July 8 after suffering a stroke that weakened her left side and caused her difficulty in speaking.

A hospital spokeswoman said doctors predict full or near-total recovery in three to four months. Associated Press
