**Rabbi Korff Urges**

**End to Nixon 'Ban'**

MISSION HILLS, Kan., Aug. 16 (UPI)—Four years ago, Richard M. Nixon led the Republican Party to its most lopsided presidential victory in history. Today, he is "an unmentionable" at the party's national convention.

Rabbi Baruch Korff, long-time Nixon friend and the former President's chief confidant in his San Clemente exile, asked Republicans Sunday to end Nixon's status as a nonperson, recall his achievements for the party and reject his role in Watergate.

Nixon, who resigned two years ago, <sup>15 AUG</sup> was not invited to the convention. No portraits of him are on display and his name is deleted from the GOP platform. \*
