SAN CLEMENTE, Calif. (AP) — David Frost will probably interview Richard M. Nixon in December at the former president's seaside villa for four syndicated television programs next year, according to a Frost spokesman. Frost has said Nixon will respond in four, 90-minute interviews to questions

about his career, his presidency and the Watergate scandal that drove him from office.

The interviews are scheduled to be aired beginning next February and March, prior to publication of Nixon's memoirs, said Wayne Baruch, vice

president of Syndicast Services Inc. of New York, which is marketing the show. They will be shown on stations that have individually purchased the syndication rights, he said.

"Nobody will know what these telecasts contain until they go on the air," Baruch said. "There will be a tremendous amount of security."
