Edward J. Gurney, the former Senator from Florida who was acquitted last week of a perjury charge in connection with a political fund-raising scandal, is undertaking a new fundraising campaign this week. "I don't think I can get into trouble with this type of money-raising operation," said Mr. Gurney. The new drive is to raise more than \$250,000 that Mr. Gurney says he owes in legal fees for his successful defense against charges that included lying to a grand jury about an alleged political shakedown scheme carried out by a former aide to Mr. Gurney.
