

WASHINGTON — Frances Liddy, wife of convicted Watergate burglar G. Gordon Liddy, has presented petitions to the Justice Department containing signatures of 7,000 persons who want Liddy released from prison. Liddy marked his 46th birthday yesterday in Danbury (Conn.) Penitentiary. He is serving 6 to 20 years for the break-ins at the Democratic National Committee's Watergate headquarters and the Beverly Hills office of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist.
