

The team known in journalistic circles as "Woodstein" has broken up. Carl Bernstein, whose Watergate reporting with Bob Woodward won a Pulitzer Prize for The Washington Post and served as the basis for the best-selling book and hit movie, "All the President's Men," is resigning from The Post effective Jan. 1. "It is very hard to leave, but I've worked for newspapers since I was 16 years old—half my life," said Mr. Bernstein. "I want to try other kinds of journalism." He will concentrate on writing books. Mr. Woodward will continue on the staff of The Post as an investigative reporter.
